## Shelf Life Testing, Predictive Modelling and Challenge Testing





Shelf life testing, predictive modelling and challenge testing are all ways in which the potential for either spoilage organisms or pathogens to grow and produce sensory or food safety issues within a product over the course of the products shelf life is assessed.
